____ **Xi Alpha Beta Scholarship** - \$150 cash award to a student going on to school.

____ **Calais Rotary Club Scholarship** - Awarded to a Calais High School Senior. Amount of scholarship may vary according to decision of the scholarship committee. Candidates must be in the upper 25% of the class. Scholarship may be split between qualified applicants.

____ **St. Croix Council #149 Knights of Columbus Award** - Awarded to a student going on to school. Preferences will be given to son/daughter of Council members.

____ **Milltown Athletic Award** - To an outstanding athlete going on to college. \$150.00 cash award.

____ **Congregation of Chaim Yosef Memorial Scholarship** - Established by Burton and Jessie Baig to memorialize the Synagogue that was originally on North Street in Calais. This scholarship amount will depend on the interest accrued on \$10,000 principal administered to Calais Federal Savings and Loan Association. Recipients must have been accepted in a properly recognized post-secondary educational program leading to an earned bachelor degree, associate degree, certificate of completion, or qualification for license for a particular vocation or occupation.

____ **St. Croix Lodge #46/Masonic Scholarship** – is awarded to a Calais High School Senior. Candidates must submit a list on a separate sheet of paper of (1), family members who are Masons plus (2), briefly explain how the education you receive will improve yourself and your community. Award amounts vary. Students must pass all classes and be accepted for the 2nd semester.

____ **Calais Athletic Booster Club Award** - Awarded to a high school athlete going on to school.

____ **Nicholas John Leon Memorial Academic/Athletic Scholarship** – Established by the family in memory of Nick Leon, Class of 1999. Awarded to an exemplary graduating senior who exhibits character and leadership in school. This senior must have participated in a varsity sport, excelled in academics and is pursuing a post-secondary education.

____ **Calais High School Student Council Scholarship** - Awarded to a student going on to school.

____ **Calais High School Academic Decathlon Scholarship** - To a graduating decathlete, must specify years of team membership.

____ **Frances McIntee Phelan Memorial Scholarship**- \$100 Awarded to a student going on to school.

_____ **St. Croix Regional Nurses Association** - Awarded to a student going into the nursing field. Award will be made the 1st semester of the second year.

_____ **Calais Regional Hospital Auxiliary** - Awarded to a student going into the medical field. \$500.00 Award will be made the 1st semester of the second year.

_____ **Jo Boehm Nursing Scholarship** - Established in memory of Jo Boehm and Reitha Scribner. A \$500.00 scholarship offered to a graduate pursuing a nursing career. If there are no candidates, someone enrolling into the medical field will be considered. \$250.00 will be paid each semester.

_____ **Clarence Beckett Scholarship** - Awarded to a Calais High School senior who has participated in track and field or cross country. Student must be attending the University of Maine at Orono. Amount of scholarship will vary according to interest earned.

_____ **WQDY Scholarship Award** – Preference is given to a graduating senior pursuing a career in journalism or broadcasting.

_____ **Billy Townsend “Firefighter” Memorial Scholarship** – Established by the family in memory of Billy Townsend. Awarded to a student who will be going on to pursue a career in fire fighting or who participated in fire explorer program and is planning to go on to college.

_____ **Alexander/Crawford Scholarship** - To a student from either town who is graduating from Calais High School. Get Application from Mrs. Brewer.

_____ **Holmes Fund** – The Holmes Fund was established by the estate of Josephine C. Moore and provides scholarships to residents of Calais wishing to pursue higher education.

_____ **John & Bessie Adams Scholarship Fund** – The Adams Scholarship was funded by the estates of John Adams and Harriette Gardner. It provides support to graduates of Calais Memorial High School who are pursuing post-secondary education. Preference is for residents of Calais.
